

DuPage Water Commission Attends Cantigny's First Green Fair

On Saturday, September 26th, 2009, DuPage Water Commission Water Preservation Group Member Jenessa Nesbitt was in attendance for Cantigny's First Green Fair from 10am-4pm. Rain gauges, leak detection tablets, 5 minute shower timers and a variety of pamphlets educating the public on how to better use water so it is not wasted were handed out. The pamphlets included titles such as Outdoor/Indoor Water Use, Rain Barrel Information, How to Fix a Toilet Leak, Lawn Care, and How Much Water Do You Use?

DWC's life-size rain barrel display complete with siding and gutters was present. This helped passers-by really get a feel for how to set up a rain barrel.

A display of a dual flush toilet was also present. There were many people that were unaware that this was available for purchase and grew quite a crowd.

About 100 rain gauges, 50 shower timers, and 150 informational pamphlets were handed out.

Other activities besides vendor/information booths were art contests, live bands, a FashionEcoNista Show, Recycling Booth, Raffle Prizes, Organic Farmers Market and Wine Tasting, and much much more. The event drew a crowd of approximately 4,000 during the day's activities.
